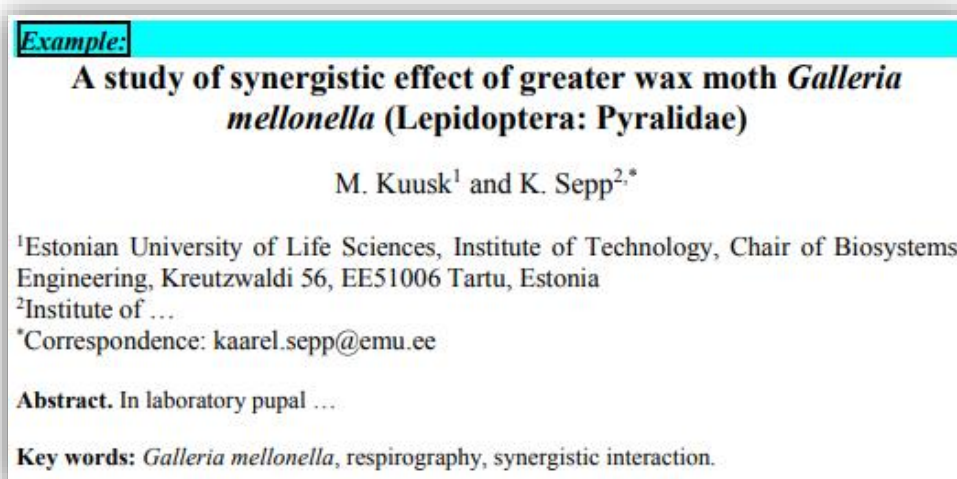

REQUIREMENTS FOR ABSTRACT AND ARTICLE PUBLICATION:

Abstracts (MS Word document, Times New Roman, size 11pt; up to 250 words; see the example below) should be sent to following e-mail: polli2020@emu.ee before **April 1, 2020**.

The abstract file should be saved with title: Surname_name_Polli100.doc/.docx



The submission of scientific articles of accepted abstracts are expected until **August 1, 2020**. The articles should be prepared in accordance with the requirements for scientific articles (see <https://agronomy.emu.ee/submit-manuscript/>) and sent to the e-mail polli2020@emu.ee. Articles sent to the editorial board must be original material and unpublished before in the other print publications. **The editorial board of the Agronomy Research reserves the right to reject articles that do not meet the proposed requirements.**

Requirements for poster presentation

Maximum size: 70 cm (width) x 120 cm (height).

Structure:

Title (title of the report, authors, organization name, e-mail address)

Introduction

Objects, conditions and methods of research

Research results (as figures and tables)

Conclusions

Font no less than 24 pt. Drawing size is at least 20 x 30 cm.
